## Project Description

According to FMO website, MCP II will pursue the same investment strategy as MCP I, which is to invest in lower middle market companies in Turkey in a broad range of sectors with attractive risk-return dynamics in terms of growth, consolidation and regional expansion opportunities. Mediterra intends to make 10-12 investments in the range of €15 - €30 million in the form of control oriented buyouts and growth capital. FMO is supporting a well established and experienced Fund manager in Turkey. The Fund will contribute to enabling access to equity financing for the underserved mid-market space in Turkey. In particular, the Fund will target broader Turkey including to some extent the whole Anatolia region where other private equity funds are less active.

A complaint can be filed in writing, by email, post, or online. The complaint can be filed in English or any other language of the complainant. The Independent Complaints Mechanism is comprised of a three-member Independent Expert Panel and it can provide either problem-solving, compliance review or both, in either order.
