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### Project Description

The objective of this Technical Cooperation project is to provide technical support to the Ministry of Transport and Aviation to operationalize and evaluate a demonstration Pilot Project of the proposed Unified Bus System. The results of this demonstration project would provide critical inputs to the Government's future decision on an island-wide roll out of the bus unification system in the island of New Providence.



### Investment Description

- Inter-American Development Bank (IADB)

The total estimated cost of the technical cooperation is US\$530,000 of which up to the amount of US\$500,000 will be financed by the IADB's Italian Fund for technical cooperation projects on a non-reimbursable basis and US\$30,000 by the government of the Bahamas by means of an in-kind contribution. The Italian donor has authorized a decrease from 50% to 15% of the tied clause of the fund.
